Course Purpose and Objectives	<p>The purpose of this course is to teach Students about the development and diversity of Human Culture. The title combines the words 'Culture' and 'Geography' and could be very easily rephrased as: 'Cultural Landscape', meaning the existing cultural environment in its different forms. The course will present the broad spectrum of Human Cultural activity and will deal with notions such as 'Cultural Group', 'Cultural Characteristic' or 'Cultural Identity'. It will attempt to uncover the formation process of Cultural Groups and the complex relations among them.</p> <p>Students will be made to realize the various factors that affect Cultural Behaviour and will be given the necessary information to be able to distinguish Cultural Characteristics and Identity, as well as recognize Cultural Expression in its diverse forms.</p>
